Dear Parent/Carer and Students

As set out by the Prime Minister, Boris Johnson's briefing this week announcing that schools will re-open from Monday 8th March, we are making plans to re-open Write-Trak.

On Monday 8th March, the Write-Trak tutors will be fully open with all face-to-face tuition, and online/zoom lessons will be suspended. We have been through the Government Guidance and new policy to ensure that tuition is as safe for our community as possible.

I have tried to bullet point the main points to make it easier to understand.

- All students will return to tuition on Monday 8<sup>th</sup> March 2021 as stated on their weekly timetables.
- Transport will run as before.
- The tuition sessions will be unchanged. Tutors are as stated on the weekly timetable 9-9.30am to 2-2.30pm unless stated otherwise.
- All tuition will be face to face, not online and daily calls home will cease.
- All staff will be wearing face coverings unless they are medically exempt.
- Pupils should be encouraged to wear a face covering at all times as recommended by the government although this will not be enforced unless the tutor specifically states this prior to tuition commencing on 8<sup>th</sup> March (unless the student has an exemption).
- Tuition is set up to maintain social distancing wherever possible.
- All tutors will be tested once a week (Lateral Flow Tests).
- We strongly recommend that students are tested weekly (Lateral Flow Tests). Please book a symptom free Covid-19 test via the government website <u>www.kent.gov.uk/social-care-and-health/health/protect-kent-and-medway/test-</u> <u>and-trace/symptom-free-testing</u> and follow the booking procedure.
- Write-Trak continue to implement their stringent Policies and Procedures, risk assessments, and COVID-19 risk plans are in place for tutors and each pupil.
- For our pupils who attend Rowhill for Motor Mechanics, this will resume week commencing March 22<sup>nd</sup>, therefore students will remain on remote learning from Rowhill until then.
- For students attending Rowhill Make Up and Beauty Therapy we are waiting for an update and will confirm arrangements once this is reinstated.
- All students will return to full-time provision and the weekly timetables will be issued next week.

## **COVID-19 REMINDER**

As a reminder, we have summarised the Government Guidance regarding Coronavirus symptoms and ways in which to reduce the transmission below.

## Symptoms of COVID-19

The most important symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19) are recent onset of any of the following:

- a new continuous cough
- a high temperature
- a loss of, or change in, your normal sense of taste or smell.
